About:

The Calaveras County Fair & Jumping Frog Jubilee is one of California's longest-running and most unique celebrations. Traditionally held the third full weekend in May, the first fair on record took place in 1893 in Copperopolis, with the fair moving to its current San Andreas location in 1932. The fair's signature event, the Frog Jump, was inspired by Mark Twain's short story The Celebrated Jumping Frog of Calaveras County, first published in 1865. Located in the heart of California's Gold Country along historic Highway 49, the fairgrounds are nestled in the Sierra Foothills amid rolling vineyards, cattle ranches, and oak-studded hillsides
